

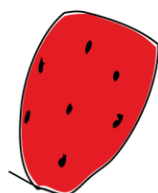


One Hundred Years - Then and Now Canadian Friends of Hebrew University Draft Itinerary for Pre-BOG Trip

| | <p>During these four days we will explore Israel's transformation through a number of diverse realms and reflect upon the dynamic and significant changes that have occurred over the past one hundred years. Over these one hundred years, the Hebrew University evolved from its modest cornerstone to its international presence in the academic, social, and cultural world. So, too, have the areas that will be explored throughout the program- Education, Urban Planning, Culture (film, art, and fashion), and food.</p> <p>Faculty from Hebrew University will be integrated into the trip.</p> |

What are the challenges? Has the education system reflected and supported the building of the State?</p> <p>Visit the Bialik-Rogozin School, an educational campus that serves 750+ at-risk children in grades K-12. The school is run by principal Karen Tal and her devoted staff, and with children and teenagers from twenty-eight countries. They are new immigrants, children of foreign workers, refugees from Darfur and Israeli Arabs. Bialik Rogozin is a caring and nurturing center that provides hot meals, music and art instruction, specialized tutoring and a safe and welcoming environment.</p> <p>Lunch at the campus of the Kfar HaYarok school hosted by Gilli Rom, Director of the Eastern Mediterranean International School and students of the school. Kfar HaYarok, "The Green Village" was found in 1950 as part of the Zionist program of David Ben Gurion and was tasked with smoothly integrating immigrant youth into current Israeli society. Hear about the schools and meet the students.</p> <p>Continue to Beit Issie Shapiro in Raanana to see one of Israel's most sophisticated schools for special education. Beit Issie is also a leader in educational technology for students with special needs.</p> |

A guided visit to this collection will give you and in-depth understanding of the unique and fascinating connections between art and the history of Israel.

Continue with Shirel to the **Florentine neighborhood** to explore another kind of art- **graffiti**. Who are the people going out at night and changing the face of the neighborhood What story do these images and words tell us about Israel today. Can we call this art or is it vandalism? What is unique about graffiti in Israel?

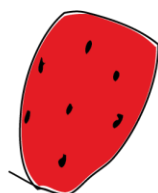
Time for lunch on your own in the **Levinisky Market**.

The afternoon will look at the past 100 years of Israel through the lens of **Fashion**. **Galit Reissman**, an award-winning interpreter of Israel history and culture through Fashion Tours will take you on a behind the scenes tour- visiting, exploring, and learning about the local creative Fashion community. Meet designers in their studios and be inspired by innovative designs and wonderful Israeli stories. The tour will include a visit to the First Israeli Fashion House, **Maskit** whose founder used her skills to empower women and aid impoverished immigrants by employing them to design and produce authentic arts and crafts and created 200 jobs. Attention will be given to the use of **technology** in fashion as well.

Urban Planning

Breakfast at the hotel

From the **helicopter pad** on the roof of the round **Azrieli Tower**, view Tel Aviv from above with **Mayor Ron Huldai** and a **city planner** who will describe the urban history and planning of Jaffa-Tel Aviv.

Meet with **Dana Azrieli**, Director of the **Azrieli Foundation**, a Canadian philanthropic organization that funds, operates and partners with a wide range of initiatives and programs in the fields of scientific and medical research, education, architecture and design, Jewish community, Holocaust commemoration, education, and the arts. Dana will speak about the foundations vision for Israel's urban landscape.

Walk through the **Azrieli Mall** to the **HaShalom Train Station** where we will reserve a private train car of the **Israel Railway** to continue the exploration of Urban Planning in the periphery of the country. We'll explore the role of public transportation in long-term planning for the country while at the same time taking in the reality of the disparity between the development of the urban center and what's happening at the end of the track.



In **Beer Sheva** walk from the train station with a view of Israel's revolutionary **Cyber Park** and across the bridge that links the train station to Ben Gurion University. Consider the challenges of the various major universities and how they differ- what are the goals of higher education in the periphery?

Lunch at **Café Ringenblum**

During the afternoon, tour the Beer Sheva area with an expert (can be from Hebrew University or other) to see the institutions and efforts that are changing the urban landscape of the south- including "**Ir Ha-Badim**" – the huge new army base.

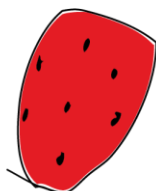

Tour the **Machane Yehuda Market** with Amit and Shmil through a Tasting Tour that will let you taste East and West-enough food for lunch and more!

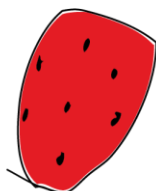
