October 28 – November 5, 2016

Friday October 28 (BLD)

Lisbon

- Arrival in **Lisbon**
- Own transfer to Sofitel Lisbon
- 7:00 pm: Shabbat dinner
- Overnight in Lisbon

Saturday October 29 (BL)

- Lisbon Synagogue for Services
- Lunch
- 2:00 pm City tour through **Lisbon's 7 Hills**. Walking tour of **Lisbon downtown (Baixa) Largo de S. Domingos** location of the **1506 massacre**, ride to **Portas do Sol** and walk down through the **Alfama Quarter** through the **Jewish Quarter**. Continue to **Belém Quarter** to visit the famous monumental quarter of the 16th century where you can visit **St. Jerome's Monastery**, and **the Tower of Belem**. Opportunity to taste the local custards.

Sunday October 30 (BL)

- 9:00 am Lecture in Hotel
- **Sintra Tour**
 Sintra was the favourite retreat of the royal family and of several romantic poets. Discover its **royal palaces** and its **Moorish castle**, classified as **UNESCO World Heritage sites**. Be delighted with the charm that envelops this town, with its aristocratic houses, the national palace from the 15th century, famous for its chimneys and tiles, the Moorish castle, or Portugal's most romantic palace, the **Pena Palace**, from the 19th century. Make sure you don't miss out on the famous 'queijadas de Sintra', a delicious traditional pastry.
- **Lunch in Sintra**
- After Sintra, we'll head to **Cabo da Roca** the western most point of mainland Europe (30 minutes). Scenic drive through the Atlantic coast to reach the cosmopolitan town of **Cascais**.
- (10 minute drive) to **Estoril** a stop at **Espaços Exílio** where we will have an opportunity to learn and discover a little bit more about Jewish refugees during WWII.

Monday October 31 (BL)

Tomar

- 8:00 am Lecture in Hotel
- 9:00 am Travel to **Tomar**
 Through the **Tagus Valley** we reach the town of **Tomar**, headquarter of the **Knights of the Temple order**, origin of Portuguese discoveries, discover the incredible convent of Christ, and its unique style.
 In Tomar's downtown we will have an opportunity to visit the oldest **Medieval Synagogue in Portugal** and **Museo Abraham Zacuto**, who saved this building.

Tuesday November 1 (BL)

Marvão, Castelo de Vide, Covilha

- 9:00 am Lecture in Hotel
- 10:00 am Journey to discover **Castelo de Vide and Marvão**, Located on the green slopes of **S. Mamede mountain range**. These hilltop towns were once strategic defence points against the Castilian menace, and the hideout for numberless Jews during the 15th century, whose heritage can be found at the local synagogue in **Castelo de Vide**.
Marvão, a fortified town also named "eagle's nest" located at the top of a magnificent cliff, offers you some of the most incredible views and sunset photo opportunities. Wander through the small white washed cobbled streets to be surprised at every corner.
Belmonte at the foot of Star Mountain is a hidden secret where for over 400 years a small Jewish community survived on its own. Visit its synagogue and the Jewish museum. Belmonte was the birthplace of **Cabral the navigator** that discovered Brazil.
- Onwards to **Sabugal and Covilha**, to discover the remains of the Jewish heritage on its quarters. The **wool textile industry** is definitely one of the remaining Jewish heritages.

Coimbra is Portugal's first capital and the city of students. Visit to the University, the oldest in Portugal, to the magnificent **Baroque Library**, and **St Michael's Chapel**. Walking tour through the old town passing by the **Old Roman Cathedral** and **St. Cross Church** one of the first colleges ever. Walking tour to discover its narrow streets and the **Jewish quarter** and the former inquisition palace.
