1. Bernice and Gordon Brown Scholarship and Mitchell Karper Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Candidates must be permanent residents of Montreal who have demonstrated academic excellence and community involvement. Candidates will agree to return to Montreal to participate in the Jewish community

Possible Award: \$5,000 - \$15,000 for one year

2. Jack Gitlitz CA Memorial Scholarship

Requirements:

3. MELS Student Mobility Bursary Program- Concordia University

Eligibility:

- be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident;
- be recognized as a Quebec Resident at their home University according to MEQ definitions;
- be enrolled full-time in a Bachelors, Masters, or Doctoral program;
- meet the Grade Point Average requirement for their Faculty;
- have received acceptance from Host Institution;
- have received approval from Concordia.

Possible Award:

The MELS has set the following maximum monthly rates for the Mobility Bursary program (8 months max): Up to but not exceeding \$750.00 per month for student exchange studies in Israel.

5. McGill Study Abroad – Mobility Award

Eligibility:

- McGill students who have financial need
- Accepted to an approved program with duration of at least 2 months.
- Undergrad students must have completed a minimum of 24 McGill Credits.
- Masters and Ph.D. students must have completed nine (9) credits of course work for non-thesis programs and one full-time term for thesis programs at time of application. - -
- Graduate students are not eligible if they are in additional session
- Maintain a CGPA greater than 2.7

6. Scholarships Offered by the Israeli Government to Foreign Students – Israel Ministry of Foreign Affairs

Eligibility:

- Resident of Quebec
- The applicant must hold a BA or BSc degree (or higher) and have a good record of academic achievement.
- The applicant must be a citizen of the country where he/she applies for the scholarship and be under the age of 35.
- Proof of English or Hebrew language knowledge.
- First priority will be given to candidates applying for a post doctorate program and to research students. Second priority will be given to PhD Students and to MA students. Third priority will be given to candidates for overseas programs.

Possible Award: Awards will vary yearly

Different types of scholarships are offered:

1. Summer language courses (Ulpan)
2. One academic year, or Research scholarships
