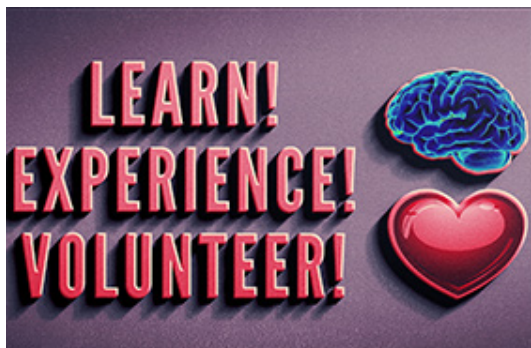
HIPPY Program To Be Launched In China And Korea
